Guidelines and Procedures:


1. One entry form must be completed for each entry. 4 entries per person. (see note for Extra Large & Large)
2. Quilts must have a 4-inch sleeve attached to the top of the back of the quilt.
3. The paper “Label” must be sewn to the lower right corner of the back of the entry.
4. Each entry must include a 2” x 3” color photo of the entry (in progress is fine).
5. Each entry must include a 2” x 3” digital photo of the quilter. (Can be taken at a guild meeting.)
6. Each entry must include a signature and date on the Insurance Waiver.
7. Entries must be delivered to the Roseville Sports Center, 1545 Pleasant Grove Blvd, Roseville on **Thursday, April 23rd, between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM.**
8. Entries must be **picked up on Saturday, April 25th, between 5:00 and 5:30 PM.** You must present your **“Receipt”** to claim your entry. **NO entries may be picked up before 5:00 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Category Definition:

Note: The perimeter is the total inches of all 4 sides of the quilt.

- 100 – Extra Large Quilts Pieced – 81” wide or wider (320” or more perimeter)
- 200 – Extra Large Quilts Appliquéd – 81” wide or wider (320” or more perimeter)
- 300 – Large Quilts Pieced – 69” – 80” wide (260” – 319” perimeter)
- 400 – Large Quilts Appliquéd – 69” – 80” wide (260” – 319” perimeter)
- 500 – Medium Quilts Pieced – 44” – 68” wide (181” - 259” perimeter)
- 600 – Medium Quilts Appliquéd – 44” – 68” wide (181” - 259” perimeter)
- 700 – Small Quilts – under 43” wide, no larger than 189” perimeter
- 800 – Miniature Quilts – miniature in scale-under 400 sq. in., **4” blocks or smaller** (80” or smaller perimeter)
- 900 – Hand Made Quilts – Hand pieced, hand quilted, hand embroidery, any size
- 1000 – Machine Embroidery – embroidery done by machine, any size
- 1100 – Custom Designed – original, personal design, combining/modifying patterns for unique items.
- 1200 – Other items – Clothing, totes, hats, bags, clothing, bed runners, table runners
- 1300 – Holiday Quilts – Any size wall hanging or quilt of annual holidays – Christmas, Valentines, Halloween, Thanksgiving or Patriotic
- 1400 – Challenge or Class Quilts
- 1500 – Art Quilts – A totally original, layered (2 or more) & stitched non-traditional work, not adapted from a pattern.
