Materials List:

- Rotary cutter – 45 or 60 mm with new blades
- Cutting mat
- Long and short rulers, 6 x 24 and 6 x 12
- Square ruler for squaring blocks
- 60° triangle ruler (recommend Clearview Triangle ruler)
- Flower pins – at least 100
- Sewing machine and ¼" foot
- Thread
- Iron
- Design wall

Fabric – from the same bolt, 7 panels for a panel One Block Wonder, or fabric

- ✓ Colors you like – 3 or 4 are better than 8 or 9
- ✓ Minimal background. Background with movement
- ✓ Avoid stripes, swirling design is better.
- ✓ Large print is good.
- ✓ Bring 2 – 4" mirrors, place in a V shape and move around fabric to get an idea of the kaleidoscope.

Measure repeat (the number of inches from where the pattern starts to where it begins again)

The repeat can be 6" to 8" up to 24" - 16" – 24" repeat are best

You will need to buy 6 repeats of 24" or 12 repeats of 6-8"- usually about 4 yards and a 5th yard if you want it for the border.
