Supply list

In this class we will be making a Jacob's Ladder variation block. After making several blocks we will try out some different layout choices.

I like this quilt using a wide variety of fabrics, so yardage requirement is difficult. Start by deciding on a color scheme – brights, yellows and greens, etc. Use a print with many colors to help your color choices if desired. Pull medium and dark scraps in this scheme (your scraps should be 5" squares or larger). Charm packs are great for this also.

You will also need a light contrast fabric. This can be scrappy or using one fabric. Depending on the size of your desired finished quilt, 2 yds of one fabric should be adequate. One of my samples uses white with black prints, one uses creamy batiks and a third uses low volume prints. All are scrappy, using what I have which is my favorite way to work.

Other supplies"

- Rotary cutting equipment including rulers

- Sewing machine (an extra wound bobbin is good)

- Neutral thread

- Basic sewing supplies

- A 6" square ruler is a great addition to your supplies if you have one.
